The support offered by the Behaviour Improvement Team includes:

- Consultation and support to schools and staff to promote best practice.
- A menu of training programmes for schools, including accredited Team Teach training.
- Direct work, and / or observation for children and young people from Reception to Key Stage 3, as requested by school.
- Support for integrating children and young people into a new school following a managed transfer from another school.
- Support for pupils reintegrating back into school following attendance at a Pupil Referral Unit.
- Restorative Justice Intervention, consultation, or school training to resolve pupil conflict.
- Helping schools to set up small groups to support children and young people who may be isolated or otherwise benefit from social skills development, using positive role models.
- Support for targeted young people as they move from primary into secondary school to help them engage effectively with their continued education.
