<b>Autumn</b>
<b><u>Romans</u></b>
Learn about the history of Rome – legend and fact – and understand where in Europe Rome is, and how the Romans came to extend their influence and create such a large and influential empire. Learn about life in Britain before the Romans arrived, look at jobs and roles in a Celtic village. Find out what daily life was like for Roman soldiers and learn how the arrival of the Romans changed life in Britain. Study Roman mosaics, understand why, when and how the Romans created these and their significance in Roman society. What buildings did the Romans build and for what purposes? How did they solve engineering problems such as providing enough water for their towns and cities, and enabling the army to get from A to B.
<b>Spring</b>
<b><u>Rainforests</u></b>
Children will discover where the rainforests are located, what they are like, who lives in rainforests (including animals, plants and indigenous peoples). Learn about the food resources available in the rainforest for the creatures and peoples who live in the rainforests. Create dioramas of the four layers of the rainforest, including the creatures found in these layers and research how rainforest creatures have adapted to life in their forest layer. Explore the life of tribal families who live in the rainforest and compare the way they live to your own family life. Celebrate the life of tribal people by sharing a feast of food and drink from the rainforest
<b>Summer</b>
<b><u>Tudors</u></b>
Children will find out what life was like for Tudor people, discover the art and music of the period, create Tudor models and artefacts. Children will place the Tudors on a timeline and explore the Tudor family tree. 2 Explore Tudor fashion through pictures and identify different pieces of Tudor clothing. 3 Investigate the foods which Tudor people ate and find out about the new foods which were being brought to England at the time. 4 Discover the punishments given to criminals during Tudor times and who oversaw law and order. They will look at the illnesses and diseases that were common in the Tudor times and discover how they were treated.
