Sequence of lessons – Objectives to be met

Lesson 1 Global Citizens	Children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise there are human rights, that are there to protect everyone• Understand the relationship between rights and responsibilities• Recognise the importance of having compassion towards others; shared responsibilities we all have for caring for other people and living things; how to show care and concern for others• Consider ways of carrying out shared responsibilities for protecting the environment in school and at home; how everyday choices can affect the environment (e.g. reducing, reusing, recycling; food choices)• I can talk about and understand how we can be responsible global citizens
Lesson 2 Global Warming	Children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise that people's spending decisions can affect others and the environment (e.g. Fair trade, buying single-use plastics, or giving to charity)• I can describe what global warming is and what we can do to help prevent it from getting worse.
Lesson 3 Energy	Children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children explain how our energy use can harm the environment and describe what we can do to help
Lesson 4 Water	Children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children describe how we can use water responsibly and understand the importance of doing this.
Lesson 5 Biodiversity	Children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children understand what biodiversity is and explain the importance of doing all we can to encourage it.
