Sequence of lessons – Objectives to be met

Lesson 1	Children will:
Know your rights	Explore and examine the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and share things which interest me. Identify human rights which all children share. understand that all people are entitled to human rights
Lesson 2	Children will:
Do human rights apply to everyone?	can identify the similarities and differences between people. I can explain what universal means. I understand that it is never acceptable to do things against human rights laws and that these laws take priority over national laws, traditions and cultural practices. I can reflect on why people may act against human rights laws and what I can do about this.
Lesson 3	Children will:
Under pressure	 Explain what a dare is. Recognise when I am being pressured into doing something. Know how to get help if I am being pressured into doing something I don't feel comfortable with.
Lesson 4 Out and about	Children will: • Know the dangers we might encounter when out and about. • List things we have in place to keep us safe in the local environment. • Can advise others on how to keep safe when out and about
Lesson 5	Children will:

Dangerous substances	 Understand what drugs, cigarettes and alcohol are. Understand the impact drugs, cigarettes and alcohol have on the body. Understand the dangers of drugs, cigarettes and alcohol.
Lesson 6 Injuries and emergencies	 Children will: Identify hazards and dangers in emergency situations. Know ways to make myself and others safe in emergency situations. Advise others on how to give first aid.
