Lesson 1 Folders	Use technology safely and respectfully. Children will revise skills from previous unit and learn to create folders. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can use basic computer skills.</i> • <i>I can use folder.</i>
Lesson 2 What is a presentation?	Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. Teachers may choose their own context for the content of the presentation, but it could relate to the current topic. The lesson focuses on what presentations are. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can organise ideas for a presentation.</i>
Lesson 3 New Slide, Slide Layout	Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. Teachers may choose their own context for the content of the presentation, but it could relate to the current topic. The lesson focuses slides and adding text. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can create a simple presentation with text.</i>
Lesson 4 Add and Format an Image	Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. Teachers may choose their own context for the content of the presentation, but it could relate to the current topic. The lesson focuses slides and adding text. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can add and format an image.</i>
Lesson 5 Reorder Slides and Present	Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. Teachers may choose their own context for the content of the presentation, but it could relate to the current topic. The lesson focuses slides and adding text. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can reorder slides and present a presentation.</i>
Lesson 6 Searching and Printing	Use technology safely and respectfully. Children will learn simple searching and printing options. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>I can search and print.</i>
